High Level Scope:

This Grant Award from the California Wildlife Conservation Boards Proposition 1 Streamflow Enhancement program will provide critical funds to complete a full-scale hydrology study and restoration planning for the Otay River Valley.

The overall objectives of this project are:

- 1. Assess current hydrologic conditions in the lower Otay River and identify priorities for future restoration and enhancement projects.
- 2. Evaluate future hydrologic conditions considering upstream development, in-process or planned mitigation projects and Climate Change.
- 3. Identify up to ten priority areas to improve streamflow in the lower Otay River valley.
- 4. Prepare up to ten "shovel-ready" conceptual restoration plans that detail site-specific actions (i.e. recontouring, invasive species removal, planting/seeding, trail improvements, etc.) to improve streamflow, habitat quality and water quality.

High Level Scope: The City of San Diego received Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Highway Bridge Program (HBP) Funding administered through the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to rehabilitate the Fairmount Ave Bridge Left/Right (East/West). The bridges, located southeast of Mission Valley in the City of San Diego, are classified as "Structurally Deficient" by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

The existing bridges are located on Fairmount Avenue at the intersection of Aldine Drive. Fairmount Avenue is a divided four lane Urban Principal Arterial that runs south-north with a posted speed limit of 55 mph in the northbound direction and 50 mph in the southbound

direction. It is a local route that primarily services the communities of Kensington and Talmadge south of I-8 and provides additional connectivity to Normal Height and City Heights.

The proposed project involves widening the existing bridges with precast concrete box girders to provide two 12-foot lanes, an 8-foot outer shoulder, a 4-foot inner shoulder, and a barrier-separated 6-foot sidewalk. Other design elements include providing 6-foot sidewalks along the north side of Aldine Drive between the ramps to Fairmount Avenue, a retaining wall along the northbound Fairmount Avenue on-ramp, and ADA upgrades. Dokken Engineering will provide Environmental Document support and PS&E services for the project.
