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ACTION & INFORMATION ITEMS:

Item 110: Absence Policy (5 min): The chair wants to make sure that all members read the policy and understand it. 600-24 and 4 in 1 year or 3 in a row.

Action: None needed, Informational only.

Item 111: Update from New San Diego City planner Dan Monroe (10 min): We asked questions by email of our planner. The questions and answers are as follows:

1- Adhami wall status?

Staff cannot support the variance project as submitted because the findings cannot be made. Mr. Adhami is exploring his civil options and is to notify me of his decision to withdraw project, move forward to hearing or modify the fence to not deviate more than 20% from the fencing regulations which we can support.

- 2- Intracorp fees....250k park lighting, 1 million in dif (DIF?) fees, when are those to be paid? I'm not familiar with this, but if it's a project, they would pay their fees at the time of building permit issuance.
- 3- Have you been involved with the update for the community plan that is being prepared by superior ready mix...removing Tierrasanta blvd from the plan?

Yes, I am the planner for both Navajo and Tierrasanta now and will be involved in the Superior Ready Mix project. They are not proposing development within the portion of their site that lies within Tierrasanta.

4- If the superior project builds within the Tierrasanta side of the community plan does the developer pay dif fees?

If they did develop on the Tierrasanta side of their property, I would expect that they would pay Tierrasanta DIF only for the development that falls within the community boundary.

5- Is a redevelopment area exempted from dif (DIF?) fees?

No, redevelopment areas are not exempt from DIF or FBA fees.

6- Status of the bicycle master plan?

I believe the City has chosen a consultant for the Master Plan but I don't think they're on board yet.

Action: None needed, Informational only.

Item 112: Postponed Filling of the Vice President Vacancy (5 min): We are planning to call a bylaws committee meeting to propose the change to the bylaws in late June or July.

Action: None needed now, as we are planning to convene the Bylaws Committee to consider elimination of this seat.

Item 113: COW status update from all members (5 min): All members are required to take the community orientation workshop with the planning dept. This item is to make sure all members have taken the class in order to gain indemnification.

Raad Attisha, the owner spoke. Requested approval for beer and wine license. Jeff Strader, corporate employee for 7-11, explained reasons why he believes the owner should be given a beer and wine license. **President Hasson** explained that council's task is to decide if we want to recommend to the police dept. to put the owner's request on their agenda. Applicant said alcohol would be available from 3-10 pm at the store. Scott said the police dept is looking for community feedback on this issue. Director Campbell asked about the trees that were cut on the property. Applicant said the stumps will be grinded down. Jeff Strader said that customers are asking for alcohol to be sold, and a petition has been brought to the meeting tonight with over 1000 signatures from the community. Applicant said they have informed the Christian church and Farb Middle School, both very near the 7-11, and that the church and school have had an opportunity to respond in writing, and they have not done so.

Treasurer Zuckerman made a motion for TCC to support w/conditions that applicant will only sell 6-packs and above, 3pm -10 pm M-F and Sat & Sun 10 am – 10 pm. Director Campbell 2nd. Vote was 13 to 4 to approve the application.
