METAL FABRICATION SUPERVISOR - 1616

DEFINITION:

Under direction, to plan and supervise metal work functions in the repair and maintenance of automotive, construction, and industrial equipment; and to perform related work.

*** EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:**

- Plans, schedules, lays out, and assigns work to welders, machinists, body and fender mechanics, and equipment painters engaged in repairing and overhauling automotive and industrial equipment and performing other metal fabrication duties;
- Inspects work in progress and upon completion;
- Instructs subordinates in difficult repair work;
- Designs and draws sketches for metal fabrication jobs;
- Determines materials used;
- Prepares budget and cost estimates and work schedules;
- Prepares and approves orders for repair parts and materials;
- Enforces safety regulations;
- Maintains records and prepares reports;
- Trains and rates the work performance of subordinates.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Please note: the minimum qualifications stated below are a guide for determining the education, training, experience, special skills, and/or license which may be required for employment in the class. These are re-evaluated each time the position is opened for recruitment. Successful completion of a State accredited four-year Apprenticeship Program, **AND** two years of full-time journey-level experience as one of the following: body and fender mechanic, equipment painter, machinist, or welder; **OR** six years of full-time experience in all phases of journey-level work in one of the above listed trades; **OR** an equivalent combination of journey-level body and fender mechanic, equipment painter, machinist, or welder experience and apprenticeship training as specified above equaling six years. Possession of a valid California Class C Driver's License.
