AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER FIVE, ARTICLE  
THREE OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY  
ADDING NEW SECTION 53.17, RELATING TO SAFE  
STORAGE OF FIREARMS.

This Ordinance, titled the Safe Storage of Firearms, requires people who keep firearms in their home to store them in locked containers or disable them with a trigger lock unless the firearm is on their person or in the immediate control of the person so that they can readily retrieve and use the firearm.

This Ordinance also provides that a person who reports a firearm lost or stolen with a law enforcement agency will not be subject to prosecution for violation of the Ordinance for the firearm that is reported lost or stolen.

This Ordinance will be enforced criminally as provided in San Diego Municipal Code section 12.0201.

This Ordinance contains a notice that a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
